isn't the most practical addition to an AR. That said, a few seconds behind this ingeniously impractical device will prove to anyone that Barrel Flamethrower) is the most fun firearm accessory yet devised. (It's also handy for burning things, but we'll get to that.)

WHAT IS IT?

The Pulsefire UBF is not a traditional flamethrower. You know, the dangerous kind used in World War II or Vietnam that use a pressurized backpack fuel tank and a pilot torch to send burning liquid up to 100 yards. A clever kickstand is built in. Once That's not this.

The Pulsefire UBF is a 6-pound unit that clamps onto a Picatinny rail and is built to be as safe as possible. It uses a high-pressure fuel pump powered by a 12V lithium battery to squirt straight

'll concede that a flamethrower gasoline or up to 50-percent diesel/ gas mixture up to 25 feet. As the fuel leaves the unit, it's ignited by a continuous electric arc ignition.

I tested the flamethrower on a Exothermic's Pulsefire UBF (Under Fightlite SCR Raider in .300 BLK. Operation is simple. To begin, flip the power switch to On and open the fuel valve. The Pulsefire UBF is now ready. Press the trigger button and — Woooosh! — the UBF spits fire like a dragon. When you release the button, the flame stops.

> The tank holds a quarter gallon or around 20 seconds of fuel. To refuel the unit, remove the Pulsefire UBF from the AR and lay it on its side. deployed and the unit is stable, refuel. For longer burn times, Exothermic sells the Pulsefire Backpack Kit for \$300. This 3.3-gallon backpack tank extends runtime up to 4 minutes. That's a lot of burning.


